**Classes are as follows:**

**Elementary – Single Class (E-1)**  
1 Racer, ages 12 yrs and under

**Elementary – Multi Class (E-2)**  
2-6 Racers, all ages 12 yrs and under

**Junior – Single Class (J-1)**  
1 Racer, ages 13 yrs to 18 yrs

**Junior – Multi Class (J-2)**  
2-6 Racers, all ages 13 yrs to 18 yrs

**Adult – Single Class (A-1)**  
1 Racer, 18 yrs and older

**Adult – Multi Class (A-2)**  
2-6 Racers, 18 yrs and up

**Family – Multi Class (F-2)**  
2-6 Racers, at least one adult and one child

**Business – Multi Class (B-2)**  
2-6 Racers, no age limitations

**Showcase – Judging Class (S-2)**  
Must race in one of the classes above  
Judged on appearance, workmanship and creativity  
Adult Class: 18 and older – Cash Prizes  
Kids Class: Under 18 – Cash Prizes



**CARDBOARD CLASSICS  
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**CONSTRUCTION OF SLEDS**

**DIMENSIONS: (No exceptions will be made)**

- \* Max WIDTH = not greater than eight (8) feet
- \* Max LENGTH = not greater than twenty (20) feet
- \* Max HEIGHT = not greater than eight (8) feet

Sleds will be made entirely of cardboard, tape and glue. Paint, paper and wax may also be used anywhere on the sled.

- \* Cardboard - can be of any type.
- \* Tape – most types can be used (see restrictions below)
- \* Glue – most types can be used (see restrictions below)

**YOU MAY NOT USE:**

- \* Plastics of any kind
- \* Epoxy - Resins - Fiberglass
- \* Bondo – Wood – Metal - Rope and/or twine anywhere on your sled.
- \* No staples, nuts, bolts, washers, wires or similar type fastening devices.
- \* String can be used for decoration *ONLY*, not for structural stability.



**RACING OF SLEDS**

- \* Running push starts are **not** allowed.
- \* Push starts by racers while inside their sled **are** allowed, but only if the racers use their hands. **No** pushing off with the legs, or “kicking” off will be allowed.

**COMPETITION OF SLEDS**

Two (2) sleds will run the set course at the same time. The first racer/racing team and sled, determined by the finish line judges, to have entirely crossed the finish line is the winner (even if the racers have to push or pull the sled over the finish line).

- \* Sleds must slide down the track, not roll down the track.
- \* Racing officials may deem a sled and/or racer “unsafe” and appropriate action will be taken, which may include possible elimination and/or disqualification of the sled and/or racer.
- \* All winners in the 1<sup>st</sup> round will advance to the next round. Rounds will continue until two sleds remain. Racers only race against sleds in their respected classes.
- \* If a sled leaves the course while racing, it must return to the track before it crosses the finish line.

**MULTI CLASS RACING**

Racers may participate in any class that they are eligible and registered for. Using the same sled in additional classes *is NOT acceptable!* A separate sled is required for each class a racer is in. Exception: A sled that participates in the Showcase Class must race in one of the other Racing Class.



**SAFETY FIRST**

**SAFETY RULES FOR RACERS**

- \* All racers **must wear a safety helmet** or protective headgear, **NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
- \* No flammable materials, including “spray cans, lighters, etc. will be allowed during this event.
